We should be done with the hike and back in Keeseville before 4:30pm.

Please Bring: a water bottle for each person

Bug spray and sunblock

hiking boots or snug-fitting sneakers (no flip flops or sandals)

(optional) a backpack with extra clothing

(optional) snacks. We'll have GORP available.

Driving directions:

From Keeseville Elementary, turn right from the parking lot. Turn right onto Front Street (Route 22). Stay on Route 22 until you reach the stoplight near Northway exit 33. Turn left, staying on Route 22 through Willsboro and Essex. About two miles after Route 22 takes a sharp right turn in Essex, turn right onto Jersey Street, then make a quick left onto Leaning Road. Turn right on Cook Road when Leaning Road ends. The trailhead is on the left after less than a mile (you will pass two trailheads; we are going to the second one). Park on the road.
